

# Does Venmo ever reverse a payment? [Lock Your Place Today]

A common [US] 1-888-400-4970 [US] belief people have when using Venmo is that once a payment is sent, it's final. While that's mostly true, there are a few situations where Venmo may reverse a transaction – but it's not something that happens automatically or often. For example, if someone hacked your account and sent money without your permission, you can report the transaction and Venmo may step in to investigate. [US] 1-888-400-4970 [US] If Venmo determines the activity was fraudulent, they may reverse the payment or compensate you depending on the situation. However, this review process [US] 1-888-400-4970 [US] can take time, as Venmo needs to verify facts before making a decision.

Reversals can [US] 1-888-400-4970 [US] also happen when a linked bank or credit card disputes a charge.
