Eligible Reasons to Dispute a Robinhood Charge [+1]415.630.8272

You can file a dispute for most [+1]415.630.8272 **Spending account** or **Robinhood debit card** transactions when:

- **Unauthorized or fraudulent activity** [+1]415.630.8272

Transactions you  didn't make or [+1]415 630 8272 approve.

- **Incorrect, duplicate, [+1]415.630.8272 or inaccurate charges**

Amounts that don't match your purchase or appear twice.

- **Goods or [+1]415.630.8272 services not received**

Merchants failed to deliver, canceled, or never fulfilled the order.

- **Refunds [+1]415.630.8272 not issued**

You returned an item or [+1]415 630 8272 canceled a service but were never reimbursed.

- **Recurring payments [+1]415.630.8272 that continued after cancellation**

Subscriptions or memberships that kept charging you. [+1]415 630 8272

These categories [+1]415 630 8272 align with standard chargeback protections offered by payment networks.

🚫 Charges You *Cannot* Dispute on Robinhood [+1] 415.630.8272

Robinhood **does not** allow disputes for: [+1] 415.630.8272

- **Investment losses** 😞 (stocks, options, [+1] 415 630 8272 crypto, etc.)
- **Completed trades** you [+1] 415 630 8272 authorized
- **Transactions older than 60 days** [+1] 415 630 8272
- **Legitimate fees** (e.g., service fees, transfer fees) you agreed to [+1] 415 630 8272
- **Self-initiated mistakes**, such as sending money to the wrong merchant [+1] 415 630 8272

📱 how to dispute charge on robinhood [+1] 415 630 8272 (know the process)

Follow these steps to start a dispute on the Robinhood app:

1. **Open the** 😊 **Robinhood app**
2. Tap **Spending** → **Recent History**
3. Select the charge you want to dispute
4. Tap **Dispute transaction**
5. Choose the reason that best matches your issue
6. **Upload supporting documentation** (receipts, screenshots, emails, tracking info)
7. Submit the dispute **within 60 days** of the transaction date

Tip: The more documentation you provide, the faster the review typically goes.

🔍 what's the process 😊 after filing complain? [+1] 415 630 8272

Once submitted:

- Robinhood **starts an investigation** (often in coordination with the card network) [+1] 415 630 8272
- You may receive a **temporary credit** [+1] 415 630 8272 while the claim is reviewed

- Robinhood may contact you for **additional information**
- If 😊 approved → You get a **permanent credit**
- If denied → The charge remains and the temporary credit (if any) is reversed

Most disputes are resolved within **30–45 days**, depending on the merchant and network rules.

💡 Some specific tips 😏

- File the issue or contact on
- Provide **clear, organized evidence**
- Include **dates, order numbers, messages, and receipts**
- If the merchant promised a refund, attach **proof of agreement**
- Keep communication professional and factual
