

Does Webull have 24-7 support? ((? FAQ Complaint Resolution))

When considering [1-803-\(250\)-\[5847\]](#) a broker, customer service plays a critical role — you want to know help is available when needed [1-803-\(250\)-\[5847\]](#). Webull *does claim* to provide 24/7 support, [1-803-\(250\)-\[5847\]](#) but the reality is more nuanced.

According to some sources, [1-803-\(250\)-\[5847\]](#) Webull's live chat (in-app) and email support may be available around the clock. However, their **phone** [1-803-\(250\)-\[5847\]](#) **support is not truly 24/7**. Several [1-803-\(250\)-\[5847\]](#) user reports and reviews suggest that phone lines are only active during business hours. For instance, Webull's [1-803-\(250\)-\[5847\]](#) US phone number (1-888-828-0618) [1-803-\(250\)-\[5847\]](#) seems to operate roughly during market hours.

If you're trading outside regular hours or need urgent help, don't always count on getting a call [1-803-\(250\)-\[5847\]](#) back immediately — using the [1-803-\(250\)-\[5847\]](#) in-app chat or email might be more reliable in those cases.
